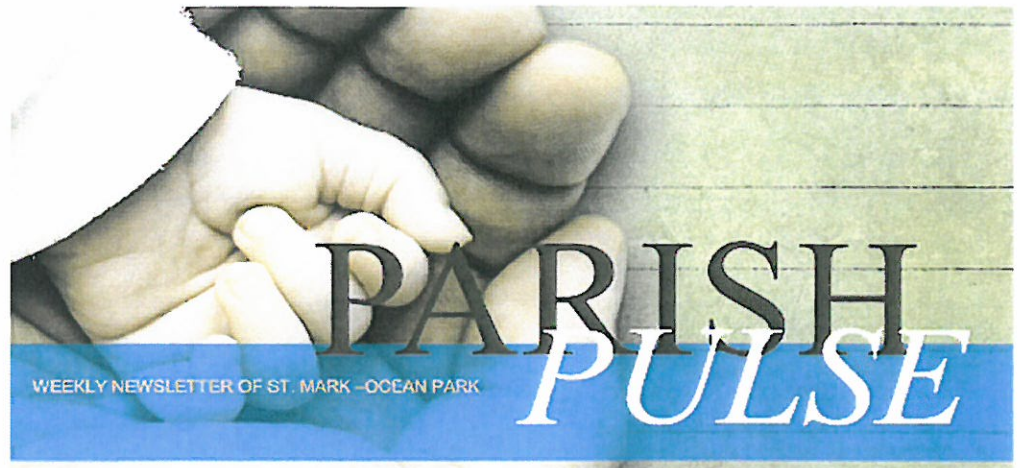

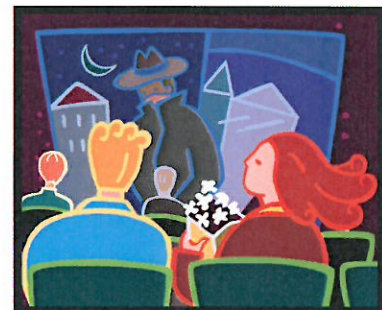

PIANO RECITAL

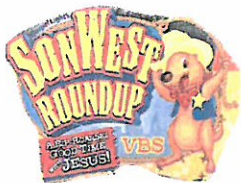
Janet Rendell is having a recital for her piano students on Sunday, June 16 at 1pm in the sanctuary.
