

Interested in the Women of the Bible? Have a look at A FAITH OF HER OWN by J. Ellsworth Kalas.

Kalas takes a look at several different women of the Old Testament such as Eve, Naomi, Huldah, and Mirriam. He examines the scriptures to see what we can learn about them and from them, including their defining characteristics, how they fit into as well as shaped the Old Testament story, and how their stories of strength, courage, perseverance, and faith have shaped out lives as believers today.
