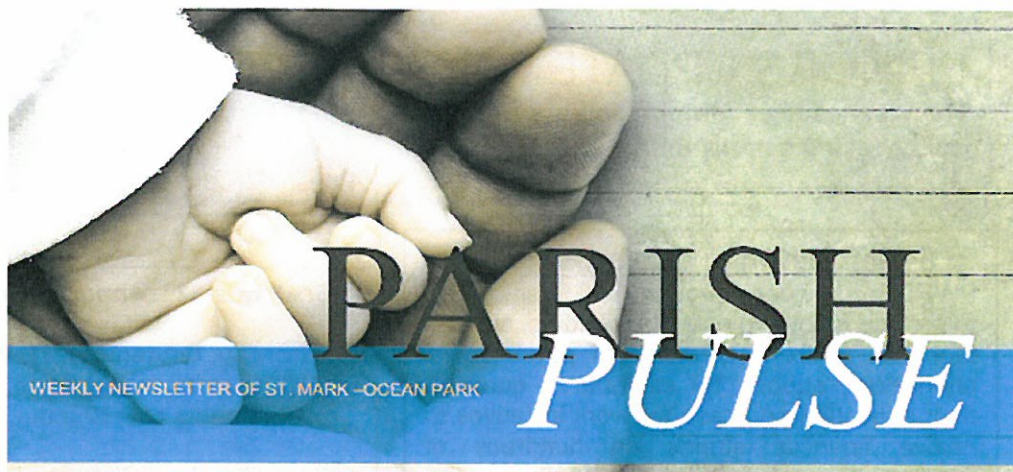

"A New Way Forward" community celebration at BC Place will close the Walk.
