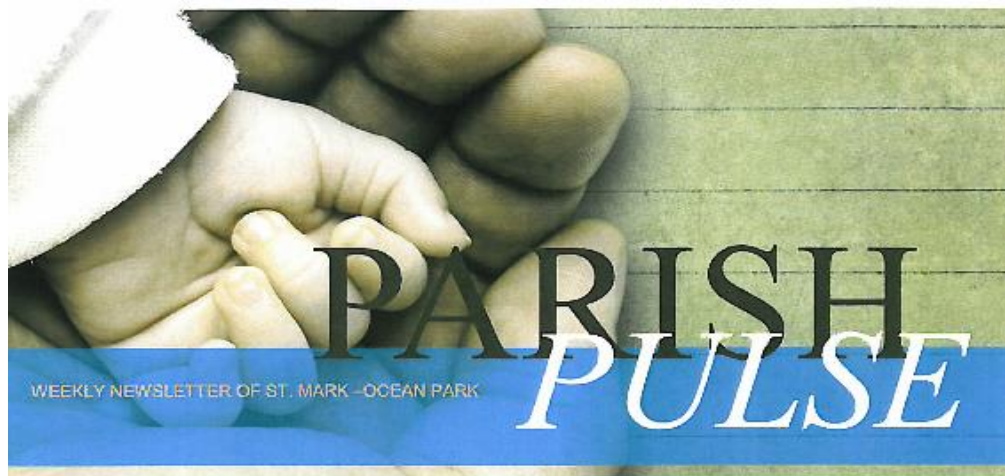

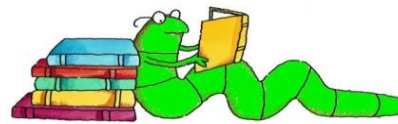
The flower calendar is up & ready for you to sign up. Please sign up soon so that your date isn't taken. We have spaces for 2 people on each Sunday.
