The Chapel in the Woods – First, a bit of background for those who are new to our Parish. The original Chapel was a consecrated space in the woods behind the Church, where occasional Sunday services were held in a colourful, fragrant, and serene setting. Over time, this area became focused on the Journey of Christmas tableaus, and the ground in the Chapel was reabsorbed into its natural state.

However, this lovely forested space has always remained in the hearts and minds of many as a blessed resource of St. Mark's. Over the past few years parishioners have discussed re-creating the Chapel in the Woods and funds have been generously donated for this purpose. The chapel can be used by the Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, Youth Group, Bible Studies, for Church services, as a contemplative holy space for prayer, for special services, etc., and for use by community groups such as Brownies and Scouts.

Following lots of prayer, study and consultation, a report was prepared last year by the Braddocks with input from approximately 20 interested parishioners. It was recommended that up to \$5,000 be authorized from bequested funds to help re-establish the Chapel. Because they are bequested funds, and not operating funds, the money spent wouldn't increase any deficit we have. The Chapel report and expenditure were discussed at Parish Council on April 29 this year and approved by Parish Council in May.

It was felt that the altar and seating should be low maintenance and integrated into the woodland setting, but be flexible to meet diverse possibilities for use of this space. To this end, some free bark mulch was used to help level the chapel site and 10 polywood benches and an altar table were purchased, which were assembled on Tuesday this week. Now, we are looking at various ways to securely install the furniture in the Chapel. This autumn we will be adding some greenery to the chapel to enhance the privacy and natural beauty of the site.

Westminster - We are pleased to announce that our new Bishop, The Right Reverend Melissa Skelton, has awarded the Order of the Diocese of New Westminster to Ken Turnham. His membership in the Order is a sign of gratitude for his many years of faithfully serving the church with distinction, and for all he has done in Christ's ministry at both St. Mark's and at the diocesan levels. <u>Maintenance Coordinator</u> – After many years of dedicated and faithful service Les Edmonds has decided to retire. A celebration of Les's custodial ministry is planned for Sunday, Sept. 7.

We are formally advising the members of our Parish of a competition for the position of Maintenance Coordinator. The job requires about 20 hours of work a week, usually spread over 5 days a week, with days worked being negotiable. It pays an honorarium of \$750 per month. To qualify for this position, the prospective candidate should be able to demonstrate through job history, or volunteer work around the church, that he or she has the knowledge. skills and abilities to fulfill the job duties. Qualified candidates will be invited to an interview. To apply for this position you will need to obtain a job description, which includes a statement of qualifications, and an application form. These documents may be obtained from any church warden or the church office. All completed applications must be received by the church wardens or church office by 3:00pm on Monday, August 25, 2014.

Consultation on Marriage - As you may be aware, General Synod enacted a Resolution that directs that a Motion be brought to the floor of General Synod in 2016 that would amend Canon XXI on Marriage in the Church so as to enable same-sex marriage in the Anglican Church. This Resolution further directs that there be a broad consultation within the Anglican Church about the preparation of the Motion and consideration of particular matters specified in the Resolution. Amongst other things, this includes a biblical and theological rationale on the nature of Christian marriage. This is an extremely important step for the Church and all parishioners are encouraged to make their views known through submissions. These submissions can be in a variety of formats, including written papers or videos.
