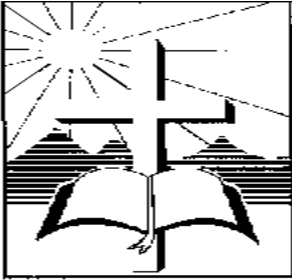
Lunch Basket for Hungry Children-is given today to the Glory of God and in thanksgiving for God's many blessings.
