PWRDF Update Partner Profile: Village Health Works, Burundi - Virginie Nizigama is one of many exceptional local women who volunteers at the Village Health Works clinic in Kigutu, Burundi. She is a bundle of energy and involved in every aspect of the clinic. She is there explaining new varieties of maize, onion and beans and how they can best grow with organic fertilizers. "No outside fertilizer needed!" Virginie is there, with other women, milking the cows, tending to the pigs and the chickens. As for the milk, that's also for the patients who need it. Virginie is there, telling women and men how to diversify their diets, grow the best varieties of vegetables so they won't need to come to the clinics as often, and to keep their children healthy for school. "We can't eat manioc all the time," she patiently explains to the others. It grows easily and quickly on the hills in Burundi, but so can many other plants that are much more nutritious.
