#### **PWRDF Update**

"Village Health Works" Burundi Where there is help, there is hope Village Health Works is a non-profit organization based in rural south Burundi. It has operated as a clinic since December 4, 2007. Using a holistic approach, VHW aims to provide quality health care in a dignified environment while addressing the root causes of illness, poverty, violence and neglect.

Health care is not easy to find in a rural setting where there are no roads and no public transportation apart from motorcycles. Health care is also hindered by religious and cultural mindsets which suggest more traditional practices, outside of the formal healthcare system. Village Health Works is part of PWRDF's All Mothers and Children Count project which is focusing specifically on maternal, newborn and child health. Burundi has a maternal mortality rate of 712/100,000, neonatal mortality rate of 28.6/1,000 and a child U5 mortality rate of 83/1,000. These are the highest rates in East Africa.



Pregnancy poses the greatest challenge because women have to travel long distances to receive prenatal care or for delivery. VHW is providing ambulance transportation to those mothers, working with a network of 200 volunteer Community Health Workers. Pregnant women benefit from high-level services provided by well-trained physicians, systematic HIV testing and other lab testing, and regular ultrasound check-ups to identify and manage any high risks for maternal or infant death. With the PWRDF support through the AMCC project, VHW is contributing to help mothers smile after giving birth rather than mourn.
