Another opportunity to attend this excellent retreat that several in our parish have attended in the past. A spiritual formation retreat, rooted in Anglican spirituality, where the Holy Spirit can move to personally transform participants to more actively engage in Christian prayer life and mission.

After a successful pilot program, "The Vita Retreat" (formerly known as "Pro Vita Mundi") is ready to be fully launched as a transformative event for the diocese. 
