### TO VOTE AT VESTRY

- 9.2 The Vestry of a Parish shall consist of all baptized persons of the age of fifteen or over:
- a) who are accustomed worshippers within the Parish and;
- b) whose names have been on the Parish List of the Parish for at least the three months preceding the Vestry Meeting.
- 9.3 For the purposes of subparagraph 9.2(a) above, indicia of an "accustomed worshipper" may include, among other things, a person's:
- a) frequent attendance;
- b) material commitment of time, talents, or financial resources; or
- c) receipt of the ministrations of the Parish because of illness or other incapacity,

though the presence of such factors shall not necessarily be determinative of a person's status as an accustomed worshipper.

Benefits of being a member:

- 1) You get to vote at the Vestry (AGM) Meeting
- 2) You receive the parish e-newsletter and other important notices.
- 3) You get a free name tag.

To vote in the next Vestry (AGM) Meeting you must be registered by Saturday, November 16.

Please check in the Hall if you are on the list. If you wish to be on the membership list you must fill out a registration form. You might also want to check that your email address, and other personal information is correct.

<u>The Mission for Seafarers</u> drive is now underway. We are looking for work socks (must have some wool in them), toques, work gloves, toiletries (male and female: razors, lotion, toothbrushes, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner etc.), small stuffed animals, puzzles (adult and children's) and magazines (National Geographic, Readers Digest, magazines about BC and Vancouver).

The purpose of this drive is to be sure that no Seafarer in the Port of Vancouver (this includes Delta Port) doesn't get a Christmas present. The small stuffed animals and children's puzzles are so that Seafarers who are heading home can pick up something for their children.
