PWRDF update on Haiti

The Primate's World Relief and Development Fund has announced an initial grant of \$25,000 to the ACT Alliance to respond to the enormous impacts of the earthquake in Haiti, the effects of which were made even more serious because of Tropical Storm Grace. More than 2,000 people have died, and approximately 60% of the population of Haiti has been affected, with thousands of homes damaged or destroyed. ACT partners on the ground have begun distribution of emergency supplies and planning is ongoing to provide water, shelter and psychosocial care. The needs assessment is ongoing. PWRDF is a member of the ACT Alliance, which issued this update.
