Steadfast in Hope

Why? So that we can fulfill the ancient call of God to his people "All peoples on earth will be blessed through you and your offspring." Genesis 28:14

How? By keeping our eyes firmly and steadfastly fixed on the ancient promises of God that are being fulfilled and will be wholly fulfilled through Christ Jesus, our Lord and Saviour.

"I am with you and will watch over you wherever you go." Genesis 28:15
"Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth ... Now the dwelling of God is with men ...
He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away." Revelation 21:3-4

Suggested Contemplative Prayer:

Spend 5 minutes each day in solitude and silence contemplating the verses above, which come from the first and last books of Scripture.

Begin by slowing your breath.

Invite the wisdom of God to guide you in this time of contemplation. Imagine yourself in the company of Jesus or being held in the palm of Abba Father's hand as you read and soak in the verses.

Notice what thoughts arise in your mind. Notice what sensations you feel in your body.

End your time asking God to seal the promises in your heart, mind, body and soul.

Consider reading these same verses from different translations on different days of the week. Notice if/how your experience changes or is enriched.

Suggested Intercessory Prayer:

Loving, faithful God we pray for our new rector, David and his family. Be with them as they transition to their new life in this community. Give them courage, wisdom, energy and a strong sense of belonging.

God, source of life, we thank you for Doris McKellar and Jack Blachford. They lived out your call to be a blessing. Reward them now as they come home to you. Be with us as we grieve the loss of their bodily presence in our community. Send angels to minister in a deep and tender way to their families and friends who will feel this loss most. Help us to continue their good work in the name of Jesus.

It is also our desire to see them grow in numbers. Thank you for Sarah and all those adults who are supporting her as she leads the children.
